Rev. Dr. Rand Peabody has served a total of fifteen Interim-Pastoral positions in the Maine and Massachusetts Conferences of the United Church of Christ. Between 1991 and 2009, he worked with local congregations navigating leadership transition in Norfolk, Weston, Arlington, Melrose, Southborough, Boxborough, Newton, Gardner, Lynnfield, Medford, and West Concord. His focus was on structural reform and systemic awareness, along with conflict resolution and spiritual re-energizing.

Rand received a Doctor-of-Ministry degree in Pastoral Counseling at Andover Newton Theological School in 1993. He and his wife, Sally, have been living happily at Brooksby Village in Peabody for the past four years.
